Currently, as a San Ramon City Councilmember, Marisol established the first Climate Action Task Force to inform the city's Climate Action Plan and to charter a Sustainability Advisory Committee. She improved access to Parks programs for seniors and people with disabilities, more workforce inclusionary affordable housing, and commonsense gun laws.
