If not might be cost effective to not have sworn officers. We have not had a shooting in our community schools. I do hear from friends in Oakland of shooting lock downs at Oakland Schools in these situations sworn Officers might help prevent this. We need more training resources for our sworn personnel to help de-escalate hostile situations.

On Rent Control: An issue that may occur if rent control is lower than inflation and cost of maintaining and or profiting from providing housing (Single Family Residential and Apartments) there may be a tendency for less commercial development of new apartments and Single-Family Residential Housing. I can provide some 1st hand and 2nd hand examples of Single Family Residential that have provided Rental Properties and Some Tenants that have been taken advantage of.

On Fossil Fuel Extraction: I have gone Hybrid in 2004 and plug in in 2019 and Fully Electric in 2021. Even though I am committed to phasing out fossil fuel extraction or drastically reducing it I think we have to be careful how we as a Party and leaders talk about this with the community at large since the majority of our working community are still using Internal combustion Engine and with gas prices going up they sometimes start feeling that they should support the Republicans. This is one reason President Biden has not allowed Ukraine to strike at Russia Oil Industry since it could raise gas prices and have more people dissatisfied with increasing energy costs
