- 1.1 Why are you running for this office? Give no more than your top 3 reasons. *
- (1) This is my life's work. Since childhood, I have found my joy and time to regenerate in nature. I chose my university training and career path—to protecting our open spaces and natural resources.
- (2) I have trained for this. I have been an advocate for environmental science, environmental justice, environmental education, and an avid parks and open space steward. I love going to work every day! My colleague said it best: "Lynda understands the connection between all terrestrial inhabitants and the environment for which she dedicates her life to protecting."

- (3) I am ready to do the job. I have almost 4 decades of experience and I have already been volunteering for more than 5 years on the EBRPD Parks Advisory Committee. I know the issues the parks are facing and I have the skills to address them. When elected I will be a knowledgeable, science driven, voting voice for the community and for the parks that we so love.

We cannot afford to have special districts like this one—act as a political stepping-stone to higher office. Those who run for this parks district, must be skilled and knowledgeable in assuming the important task of the oversight of our nation's largest regional parks district, and ensure its natural resources, and the workers who maintain them are recognized and compensated.

1.2 - What are the responsibilities that come with the office you are running for? *

The East Bay Regional Park District (EBRPD) has seven Board of Directors, who are responsible for representing the people who elected them, and to uphold the mission of the agency. Collectively we vote on policy for preserving the cultural and natural resources of the district's parks, and for providing healthy recreation for future and current generations. We have a fiscal responsibility to a balanced budget and workspace programs, and to drive policies needed for the implementation of and maintenance of the parks and its master plan. Our meetings are regulated under the Brown act, so our responsibility is to ensure we always conduct meetings, policies and legislation in the public eye. Further, we are responsible for an open and transparent process. One that encourages diversity and equitable public participation and assists in outreach and education for a fair participatory process that represents all users—and mirrors the members of our community

1.3 - What are your personal or professional qualifications that you believe make you the best candidate?

I am the only candidate with in-the-field job experience. I have degrees in Chemistry, Soil Science, and a Master's degree in business. I bring a 37-year career in environmental science, 20 at the US-EPA. In addition, I spent evenings providing public service. I already have policy experience in elected and appointed positions. I served as a Parks and Recreation commissioner, Mayor and councilmember. I served on the League of California Cities Environmental Quality Committee and on the Contra Costa County Solid Waste Authority. In addition, I have 20 years of experience as the founder and director of Contra Costa Climate Leaders.

As an advocate, I fought for settlement dollars for tribes and communities affected by toxic harms. I will fight for an equitable workforce and programs that serve the diverse needs of park users.

I honor the 7 generations principle of Native wisdom by mentoring the next generation; keenly listening, closely observing and learning from park users of all ages and diverse backgrounds..

I am the only candidate with 5+ years on the Parks Advisory Committee. I have deep understanding of our parkland challenges and the need to become climate resilient. Our parks are facing consequential challenges due to climate change – fire, algal blooms, sea level rise, and the urgency of now. I have managed large budgets for soil-contaminated cleanups and community "Right-to-Know" programs. I am an avid hiker, trained classroom educator, certified herbalist and a nature enthusiast! Experience Matters!

1.4 - What are your top goals for this office? How do you plan on achieving them? *

My priorities: https://lyndad4parks.com/priorities/

I will be one of 7 elected officials driving policy for the East Bay Regional Park District (EBRPD), the largest regional park district in the nation. I will oversee 75 parks, which covers a total of 120,000 acres. Other states and countries look to us at the EBRPD as their role model. The park district is writing its "2nd Century Plan," which is its master plan; and it will function as the blueprint for the agency going forward. I will champion and facilitate, and use my experience and deep connections, to work together to achieve and to institutionalize:

- **Climate Resilience. Implementing solutions to the climate emergency: Ensure emergency response planning and management of risks such as fire, sea level rise, drought, disease, and extreme weather events is included in all staff reports, and front and center in the new 2nd Century Plan that will be written in 2025.
- **Community Involvement. Fostering an open and transparent process. Build capacity for engaging diverse users and ensuring that our parks are accessible, including those with disabilities, and representative of the current and future needs of our Bay Area communities and cultures. Through true multiculture collaboration, I will reach out to communities that are missing from the decision-making table and make space for them in the public process so that environmental injustices, worker injustices and accessibility injustices can be meaningfully addressed.
- **Park Use Guidelines Develop science-driven criteria to minimize user conflicts and insure preservation of natural wildlife habitats.
- **Second Century Plan Shape the development of a comprehensive, forward-looking plan that combines new technologies with the wisdom of Native land stewards to guide the second century of the East Bay Regional Park District
- **A Balanced and Sustainable Budget Provide financial stability and resources needed to support a dedicated workforce, the maintenance of the parks, land acquisition, and the capital improvement & investment of safe and healthy outdoor spaces for generations to enjoy

1.5 - How do you plan on engaging your constituents in dialogue after you are elected? *

I honor the 7 generations principle of Native wisdom by mentoring the next generation and listening deeply, observing closely and learning from park users of all ages, diverse backgrounds, traditions and interests. Public involvement and building community capacity is my specialty and will be my focus. I have the experience to combine my knowledge with community voices. We have limited time to make our parklands climate resilient.

I was the manager of the Federal Community Right-to-Know Program for the USEPA Region 9 office, which provided outreach and education to underserved communities. Empowering them with important information on publicly available data on toxics releases and chemical exposures. I became a project manager for three of the nations most contaminated Superfund Sites. Each site involved extensive community engagement, community outreach and capacity building to engage and address low-income community issues of concern. I have extensive experience working in partnership with and building relationships with tribal communities and with environmental justice organizations.

I speak Spanish, and I have done training, outreach and the arrangement of materials in other languages. I will ensure the Second Century Plan includes a separate chapter on diversity and environmental justice, along with a measurable plan to ensure representation for all users, especially low-income communities. Because of my experience, I will make certain that in developing the plan, it is robust and transparent. Moreover, I will make it a priority to ensure that the communities that we serve can attend and participate in a meaningful way.

- (1) I am seeking the endorsement, because I have great respect for democracy and I am a proud active and engaged Democrat in my county of Contra Costa, where for 30 years I have used the public process to put policy and people into action.
- (2) I would proudly highlight the party endorsement in public; give it a prominent place on my website and social media posts; and give it a high profile in my campaign materials. The endorsement would also validate my past public service as an environmental scientist and as a dedicated public servant, ready to preserve and protect Bay Area parklands. Sadly today, both science and public service are undervalued and under attack by conservatives and corporate interests.
- (3) The endorsement would energize my supporters who believe that experience matters when running for seat on the park district's board, especially at a time when parkland decisions must take into account climatic changes and the impacts on our natural and built communities for years to come. 2.3 - In your opinion, which elements of the CADEM Platform are most relevant to the position you are seeking? If elected, how do you plan to advance them?

The elements that apply directly are: Energy and Environment, Climate Crisis, Energy, Environment and Nature, Environment, Water, Equality of Rights and Opportunity and Sustainable Communities.

These are all priorities of my campaign. As we write the "2nd Century Plan," the blueprint for the agency, I will work to ensure that the deliverables required in the plan are clear and measurable, and advocate for a stand-alone Climate Resilience Plan. All of these CADEM elements will be part of that plan. Moreover, in order to implement and ensure they are advancing, I will encourage ongoing robust staff reports that include a section that assesses progress and the "climate impact" along with the "fiscal impact."

When elected, I will also ensure that policy makers receive direct input from the science stewardship team so that each of our decision-making reports includes a voice for nature, a science review, and assures that policy decisions are science driven and comply with local, state, and federal guidance.

I will promote that we upgrade our energy provider to Deep Green (100% renewable energy for EBRPD operations) whenever available and financially feasible. In addition, I will encourage a new EV truck technology options review for our fleets; and consider an EPP (Environmental Purchasing Policy) that includes requirements for our contractors, as well as for ourselves. I would also work for a review of facilities and consider microgrid options for key operating locations commensurate with the need for cooling centers and emergency operations.

I will work to ensure collaboration from the other elected officials and engage community voices.

I would like to see more about history and the cultures that helped to form our parks, names that represent the first people and expand and update our indigenous information centers, and more presentations and programs like the recent Port Chicago 50 that highlights the sacrifices they made for worker's rights and racial Justice. Parklands have historical and cultural values that we need to see represented in our workforce as well as in the programs that are workers provide.

With my background as an environmental scientist, my love of nature, and my experience as a manager with a master's degree in Organizational Development & Human Resources Management, I will make certain that the plan is robust, transparent, measurable, and put into action.
